DISCUSSION GUIDE

- 1. Read Genesis 6:9-12. Do you feel like the world is "corrupt and full of violence" today? What does it mean to be righteous and blameless in today's world?
- 2. Read Genesis 6:13-22. Noah builds the ark in faith. What is the hardest thing you've ever done because of your faith in Jesus?
- 3. What are some challenges we face in being obedient to God's commands and leading in our lives?
- 4. Read Genesis 7:17-24. Imagine all the pain, destruction and death caused by the flood. Is it hard for you to reconcile God's judgement in the images of the flood with his love?
- 5. Notice the word "remembered" in these verses: Genesis 8:1, Gen 19:29, 30:22, Ex 2:23-25. What does it mean for God to remember in these verses?
 - How can we find comfort in knowing that God remembers us? Can you share a time when God remembered you?
- 6. Read Genesis 9:8-17. What is the significance of the covenant God made with Noah? How does this covenant compare with the new covenant we have in Jesus (Luke 22:20).
- 7. How would you use the story of Noah to tell the story of Jesus? (*hint, can you see the ark as a symbol of salvation through Jesus?*)

PRAYER

Reflect on this verse from 2 Corinthians 5:7: *"For we live by faith, not by sight."*

"God help us to live by faith and not by sight. Help us to be bold and holy so that the world may see you and be saved."
